

Good Day JC Family,

The Ministry of Health and Wellness has approved another Vaccination Blitz.

The dates are **Monday, September 13th to Wednesday, September 15th** from 9:00 am to 4:00pm. **There will be NO vaccinations given at JC this weekend.**

We are asking that **ALL** and **ONLY** JC students and staff be present on **Wednesday the 15th** as granted by MOHW.

You also have the option of coming on another day if you are not available for the 15th.

- Note that 2nd doses are given after 21days and it was taken into account the separate days persons were vaccinated. Please be reassured this will not affect the efficiency of the Covid vaccine. WHO recommends it be administered with a 21 to 28-day interval. Pfizer will be the vaccine that is given. Visit the MOHW website for locations of other types of vaccines. You also have the option of getting your second Pfizer dose at another location corresponding with the date on your card.
- Students please remember to carry for your second dose your vaccination card, school ID, and you must have a parent/guardian present with you.
- Adults are required to walk with government ID / passport / driver's license along with TRN if they are taking the vaccine.
- Remember to eat a healthy breakfast before arrival.

If you have not gotten the first dose that is okay! Please still come and be vaccinated. However, your second dose may be given at any vaccination center island wide at your convenience.

Jamaica College will not be providing transportation to or from any location on No Movement Days. This email can be used as verification to show your intention of travel along with your vaccination card.

N.B.

Vaccinations are **only for children 12 years and older.**Students **under 18 years of age MUST have a parent/guardian present**.

If your child has recently had a booster shot or another vaccine, they will NOT get the Covid vaccine until after 2 weeks have passed.
