BOUNDS. (Daylight)

All ground within the school fences is in bounds except:— The Headmaster's garden and the ground between the labs., the main school block, and the fence by the water course, except to go direct to the lavatories of Hospital.

(After Dark)

Only the lighted paths round the buildings are in bounds.

(At any time)

It is the privilege of the School Monitors to enter the Chapel Garden and to walk on the lawns opposite the College and Assembly Blocks.

Boys may neither hang over the Hope Road fence nor loiter unduly by the fences or gates.

No DAY BOY may go upstairs

to the Boarding Houses except to see a Master.

No boy may enter any class-room but his own except for a class or preparation or with the Special permission of a Master.

ROLL CALL — SCHOOL.

Roll is in Houses by Housemasters at 8.25 a.m. on all school days.

Any boy late for roll call will report to his Housemaster immediately on his arrival.

A boy who has been absent from school must take a note from his parents to his Housemaster immediately on his return to school.

CALL OVER.

On Saturday nights Call Over will be taken by the Master on Duty.

CHAPEL.

All boys will attend Daily Morning Prayers and Assembly unless excused by the Headmaster.

All Boarders will attend Chapel unless the service is "Voluntary."

Boys excused Chapel by the Headmaster will sit in silence in the Assembly Hall. They may read or write. The Senior boy not attending Chapel will preside.

LATENESS AND ABSENCE.

Any boy who is late or absent from any school engagement will report to the master in charge of that engagement. If he wishes to be excused on the grounds of having been detained by another master he must take a written excuse to that effect.

GAMES AND ACTIVITIES.

Games are compulsory for all boys unless they have a certificate from the Doctor.

No boy may take part in games, Physical Training or other activities except in games clothes or the appropriate uniform.

The House Captain of the game will check absence, lateness and dress.

No School Captain of a game may make any arrangements for a game without the permission of the Master in Charge.

The Gymnasium is out of bounds at all times except with the permission of the Master in Charge.

Unless posted as excused no boy may miss games to play tennis or to swim.

Any appointment to a School Captaincy etc. must be sanctioned by the Headmaster.

School team lists must be signed by the Master in charge of the game and the Head Master, House team lists by the Housemaster, and posted not less than 24 hours before the match.

There will be no "grubbing" before 3.30 p.m. on schooldays. Boys may "grub" only in games clothes and on the lower school fields.

All Day Boys must leave the school premises by 6 p.m.

The rules for Swimming are posted on the Notice Board outside the pool.

PROPERTY.

No boy may lend or borrow property without the permission of his Housemaster.

Loss of or damage to school property must be reported immediately to the Master on Duty.

BOOKS.

A book may not be lent except with the permission of a master.

Every book must have in it the stamp of the Book Office and the name and initials of the owner inside the stamp. There must be only one name written inside the stamp. It is not allowed to cross out one name and insert another. When a book is to be transferred it must be taken to the Book Office to be stamped afresh.

If one boy wishes to transfer a book to another boy, both boys must go to the Book Office.

APPEALS.

A boy considering his punishment unjust should ask to see the

Master privately and may then, if he wishes, appeal to the Head Master. The appeal may be disallowed or upheld: frivolous appeals will be severely dealt with.

GENERAL.

No Boarder may ride in another boy's car without the permission of his Housemaster.

No Day Boy may give another boy a lift in a car which he is driving.

No boy may have matches in his possession. No boy may smoke.

No boy may go on the Staff Common Room verandah or enter the Staff Common Room.

A boy wishing to see a Master who is in the Staff Common Room should wait until he comes out.

No boy may USE or ANSWER the TELEPHONE at any time.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES must be brought back at the start of term, and handed in to Housemasters immediately on arrival. Certificates may not be sent.

BOARDERS returning without their Certificates will be isolated. Day Boys will be sent home to fetch them.

Comics are not allowed in the school.

Chewing-gum is not allowed in the school.

Playing Cards may be used only at the times stated.

All boys must conform to the school dress-regulations.

No boy may speak in the Dining Hall *before* the Grace is said.

No boy may visit another boy in Hospital.

PUNISHMENT.

Boys who "cut" any lesson or detention or school engagement will be reported to the Headmaster.

Returned Work takes precedence over all other out-of-class engagements.

School Detention. No boy may absent himself from school detention unless he takes a leave signed by the Master who put him in, to the Master taking detention.

Preparation: Day Boys. A boy wishing to be excused for preparation not done must bring a note signed by his parent to his Housemaster, who will give him a written excuse for presentation to the Master concerned.

School Monitors are responsible for the observance of all rules and may enforce them by punishment.

All serious or doubtful cases must be tried by the Monitors as a court. Both before and after trial the court must allow an appeal to the Head Master.

All rules and arrangements posted on the Notice Boards must be known.

BOARDERS

All boarders will rise at the First Bell in the morning and take a shower.

After Games, Cadet Corps, etc. all boys must take a shower and be properly dressed for Supper.

Preparation. All Boarders must be seated with the required books etc., when Second Bell goes.

Any boy wishing to leave the Preparation-Room or do anything other than work will obtain the permission of the M. O. D.

All boys must wash, clean their teeth and be in bed 15 minutes after the bell, and must stop talking 10 minutes later.

All lights must be out and all talking must cease by 9.30 p.m.

FOOD.

Boys must eat the food provided unless they are on a special diet prescribed by the School Doctor.

Illness and Hospital.

Dispensary times: 7.45—8.15 a.m. and 6.00—6.30 p.m.

Except in an emergency no boy may visit the Hospital at any other time.

A boy wishing to go to the Hospital must first see the Master on Duty. He must report to the M. O. D. on his return, otherwise it will be assumed that he has been detained in the Hospital.

The Dormitory Monitor will report to the M. O. D. any boy ill at rising time: such a boy will remain in bed until Mrs. Spence visits him.

LEAVE.

Week-Ends. There will be one long week-end in the middle of the term to which all boarders will be entitled on WRITTEN permission from their parents, to be given to their Housemaster not later than the previous Saturday.

Each boarder may in addition to this week-end have **one** other week-end with written permission from his parents.

Boys may go out with their parents or friends twice a term on Saturday or Sunday between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m.

Town leave and Cinema leave will be granted in accordance with the regulation in force from time to time.
