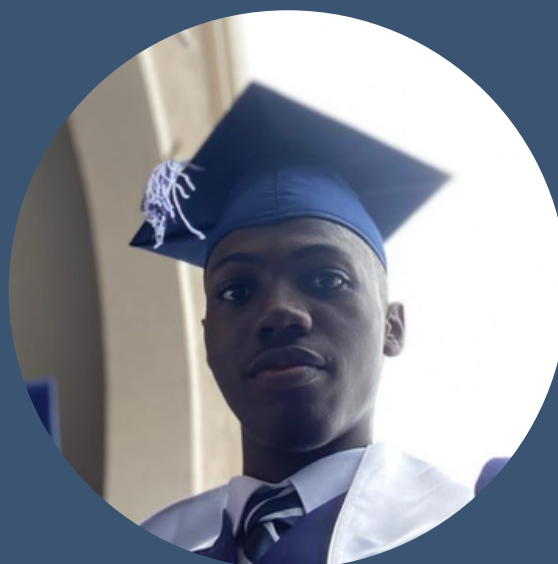

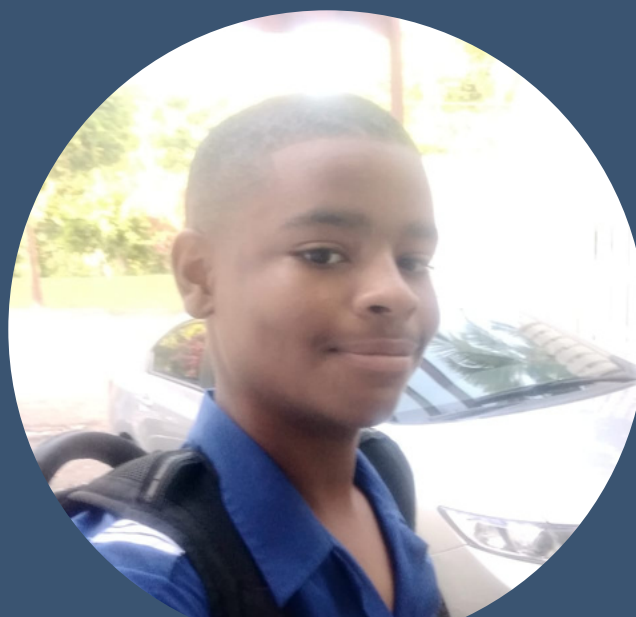
As we reflect upon the achievements of this productive month, we remain motivated to strive for even greater accomplishments in the coming month.

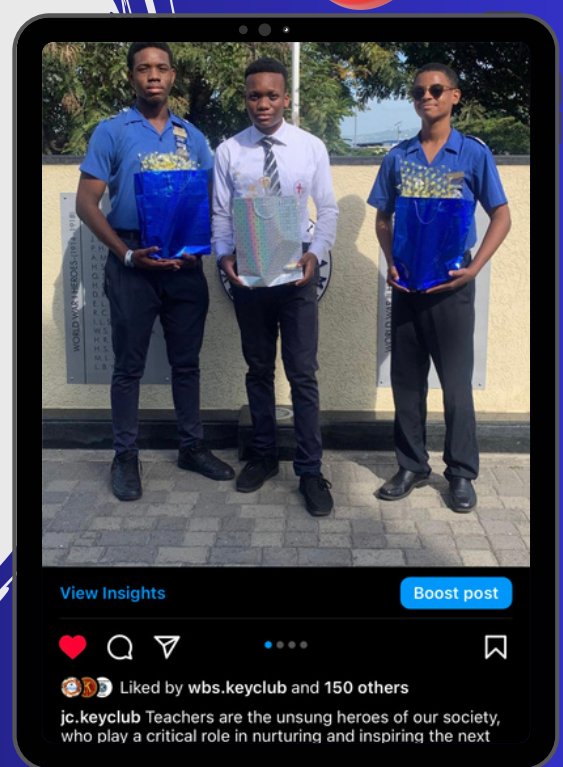
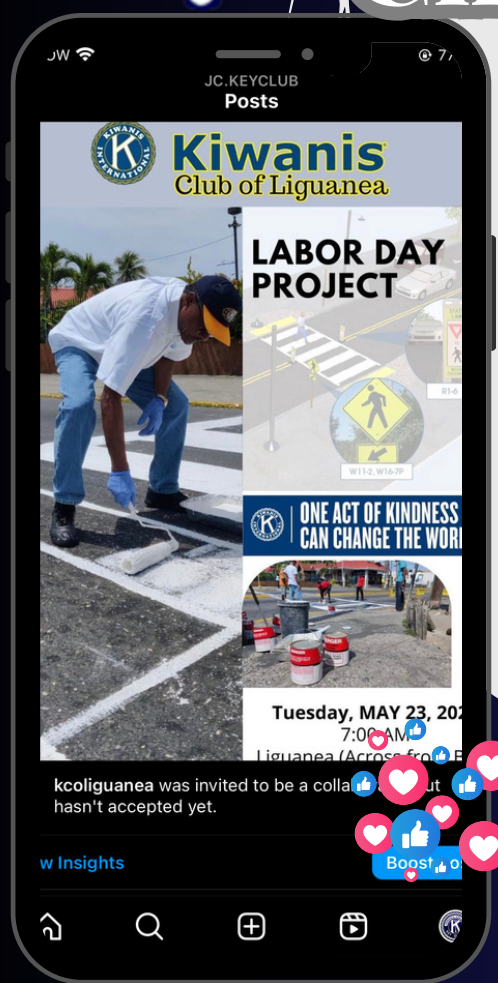

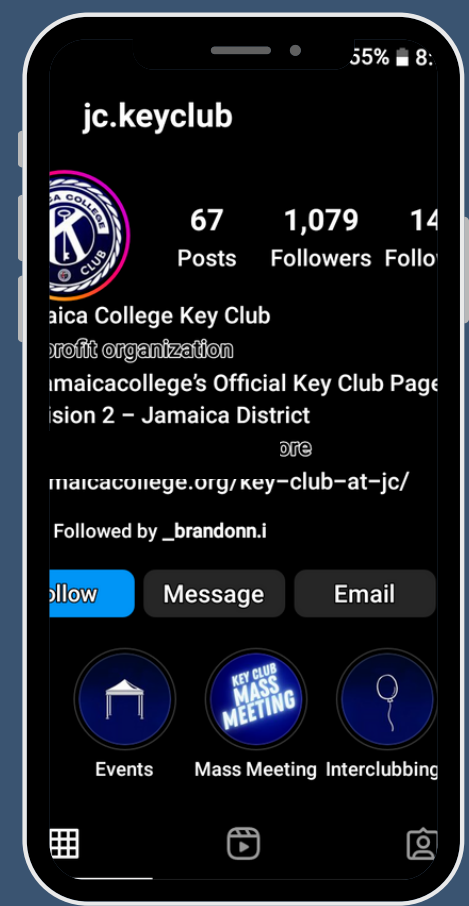
