SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

TO: Sponsors

Preamble

Students selected or recommended by the school –should have met the following requirements; Provisional acceptance by a University of choice, having fulfilled all the requirements for matriculation.

- 1. Should have been involved in at least two (2) co-curricular activities in school. (15 points)
- 2. Complete at least thirty (30) hours of community outreach service. (20 points)
- 3. Display through active involvement some leadership qualities. (15 points)
- 4. Show a degree of interest in positive mentorship of younger Jamaica College student. "College Men". (10 points)
- 5. Assessment of Financial need will play a critical part in the selection process. (40 points)

Selection of Students

- An overall weighting of 100 points will be allotted to each applicant. Criterion will be valued between 10-40 points. Assessment will be based on school reports documentations 3rd – 6th.On assessment the points will be tallied with the award made to the applicant amassing the highest score.
- All persons must make a written application to: Scholarship Chairperson of the Selection
 Committee. Applicants will be required to produce a written Essay on any of the following.
 - 1. The Importance of Volunteerism
 - 2. How my field of study will benefit the Jamaican Society.

Committee will comprise of:

- 1. Principal or his designated officer
- 2. Old Boy
- 3. Dean of Academic Studies
- 4. Dean of Student Affairs
- 5. Guidance Representative
- 6. Student Council President or Rep
